## Childcare and Sunday School for Children

Children are always welcome in worship. Children's worship bags and bulletins are available at the entrances. Children should not be unattended in the building, per our Child Protection Policy. Sunday School finishes at 10:45, so enjoy some extra time for you after worship.

The Bibles in our pews are the New Revised Standard Version (NRSV), originally produced in 1989 as an update to the 1952 Revised Standard Version (RSV). The pastors and readers are now using the New Revised Standard Version Updated Edition (NRSVue) in worship. Published in 2021, the NRSVue incorporates new manuscript discoveries, particularly for the Hebrew Bible, and the latest insights from biblical scholarship. It features clearer, more inclusive language and greater cultural sensitivity compared to prior versions, with over 12,000 substantive

revisions to the original NRSV. You can learn more about the NRSVue with this QR code.

Today is Reformation Sunday, when churches in the Presbyterian Church (USA) and other members of the Reformed denominations celebrate the day in 1517 when Martin Luther posted his 95 theses on the church door in Wittenberg, Germany. This marked the beginning of the break between the Roman Catholic church and the Protestant churches.
