
If you cannot bring your estimate of giving card to worship on November 21, you can submit your estimate of giving using one of the options below:

- † Mailing back the estimate of giving card you will receive in November.



Will you take the next step in trust?

Christ promises to take care of us while we take care of others. When we step up our giving, we can trust that God will provide for our well-being. EXPLORING

Begin to give.

GROWING

Plan a percentage of income to give for a year.

DEEPENING

Increase percentage of income toward a tithe.

CENTERED

Begin to give a tithe. (10%)

TRANSFORMING

Give beyond a tithe.
