



Curriculum for 3-Year Olds

Our Three-Year-Old program steps up the pace with play-based learning through various centers in the classroom – free art, home living, sensory table, blocks, puzzles, imagination, book nook and teacher directed tables offering skills in fine motor and cognitive development. All classes are taught Spanish weekly. Children begin to work on their handwriting and letter formation with a program called Handwriting without Tears. Social development opportunities abound. Children begin to play in a more traditional manner, developing friendships along the way. Speech is expanding and encouraged so that children learn to have a voice which can express their needs and concerns. Math skills and numeral understanding come to life for our 3-year-old students through a variety of thought-provoking puzzles, toys, and activities. Our playground offers opportunities for the students to further their physical and social development. The teacher/student ratio is 1:7.
