Curriculum for 2-Year Olds

Our Two-Year-Old program offers a caring and nurturing environment with a teacher/student ratio of 1:6. Children continue to grow in their emotional skills by feeling secure while being separated from their parents. Areas of development are supported through play-based activities. Through play, the children interact more with friends, use pretend play to understand things in more complex ways while learning important concepts such as big and small, and up and down. Parallel play emerges at this age, as they begin to play side-by-side with friends while growing in social development. Our 2's are introduced to Learning without Tears, a curriculum that introduces and instructs children on how to build letters. Art activities are offered that provide growth in small and large motor development. Circle time gives the students a chance to practice skills of listening while enjoying stories and working on cognitive skills such as colors, shapes, and counting. All classes are taught Spanish weekly. Daily playground time encourages more social interactions and a chance to strengthen gross motor skills.
